- A. Presentation by Fire & Life Safety – Al Gerard & Melissa Fechtel 30 minutes
Fire and Life Safety would like to provide the Committee with an update on their planned business fire code inspections. Beginning in 2007, they will start fire code compliance inspections in approximately 111 of the commercial occupancies located outside the City limits but within the Springfield Urban Growth Boundary. This will include commercial properties located in and around Glenwood.
