Main-McVay Transit Study & Stakeholder Advisory Committee Kickoff

The City of Springfield in partnership with Lane Transit District will convene the Main-McVay Transit Study Stakeholder Advisory Committee and kickoff the portion of the study that will explore transit options to address and enhance all modes of travel along the Main Street-McVay Highway Corridor. The Stakeholder Advisory Committee will be an advisory body to the Governance Team for the Main-McVay Transit Study. The overall goal of the Main-McVay Transit Study is to analyze the need, technical viability, and public support for potential Main Street-McVay Highway transit improvements.

The committee will meet monthly over the next twelve months. The first meeting is scheduled for May 14 with the second meeting scheduled for May 27; both from 3:00 to 5:00 PM. Meetings are open to the public.
