REIMAGINE COLOR WORKSHOP

The Springfield Library hosts a revamped color theory workshop

On Saturday, June 21, 2014 from 12:30-2:30pm, join artist Tilke Elkins for her class, *The Secret Language of Color* at the Springfield Library. The workshop is free for adults but pre-registration is required because of limited space – call the library at (541) 726-3766 to sign up.

If color was your language, what would it look like? What color-words would you choose? Would they be turquoise and grey, or pale apricot, or emerald green, or salmon rose? And how would your colors all sing to each other? Color is first and foremost about relationships. This class will unmask a series of surprising effects that colors have on each other, and teach you how to see and use color anew. This is far beyond (and far more useful than!) the color you find in basic color theory. If you have ever wished you could understand color and better apply it to your life – in art, in design, in interiors or anywhere at all – this is the class for you.
