The City of Springfield is accepting applications to fill one vacancy on its nine-member volunteer Arts Commission.

The deadline to submit applications is April 8 at 5:00 pm. Application packets are available at the City Manager's Office, 225 Fifth Street, during regular business hours and online at www.springfieldartscommission.org. **Applicants must attend the Arts Commission meeting on Tuesday, April 14 at 6:30 pm**, at City Hall in the Library Meeting Room, to meet the commission. Applicants may be asked to attend the City Council meeting on April 20, as well.

Requirements:

Commission members are required to attend evening meetings the **second Tuesday** of the month, September through June and assist, plan and develop commission projects and activities. Applicants must live or own a business at a Springfield address, which includes the 97477, 97478, or 97482 zip codes. Also, applicants must be at least 18 years old and be registered voters. Arts Commissioners serve "at-large" positions with no ward restrictions and four-year terms.
