DOWNTOWN PLANNING CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING

The next City of Springfield Downtown Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC) will be held 5:30-7:30 p.m. on Thursday, April 27 in the Jesse Maine Room in Springfield City Hall at 225 Fifth Street. The Downtown Citizen Advisory Committee meetings are open to the community. Downtown Design Standards will be discussed. The City is developing design standards for Downtown to increase its overall image, attractiveness and economic vitality.

Currently the Downtown Citizen Advisory Committee is providing input on Downtown Design Standards. The committee plays an important role in the City's Citizen Involvement Plan to ensure that meaningful community involvement is part of the planning process.
