YOUTH ART OF SPRINGFIELD SHOW**

The third annual Youth Art of Springfield Show, sponsored by the Springfield Arts Commission, is now on display in the Springfield City Hall Gallery. “Squished in a Square” is this year’s theme.

In April, 1500 students in grades K-5 completed art pieces. Each student received a ribbon from the Springfield Arts Commission and art shows were held to display the entries at each of the 11 participating schools. The following Springfield schools took part in this project: Camp Creek, Centennial, Guy Lee, Maple, Moffitt, Mohawk, Mt. Vernon, Page, Ridgeview, Riverbend and Thurston.
