“PAINTING-A-WEEK SHOW” AND SCULPTURE ON DISPLAY AT SPRINGFIELD CITY HALL GALLERY

Show features local artists Linda Shaver, PJ Sargeant and Sally LaMarche

Artists PJ Sargeant and Linda Shaver’s “Painting-a-Week” show and Sally LaMarche’s sculpture are currently on display at the Springfield City Hall Gallery until October 31st. Viewing hours are 8am-8pm, Monday and Tuesday; 8am-5pm, Wednesday through Friday and from Saturday, 12pm-5pm. The gallery is closed on Sunday

The “Painting-a-Week” exhibit showcases works the artists created after committing to complete a painting a week. PJ Sargeant completed her year-long commitment to the project in September of this year. She started the project to try a new painting style, moving from large format, painted photo collage to the current pieces which are acrylic paintings on hard board. All proceeds from sales of her pieces go toward PlayPumps International.

Linda Shaver began the painting-a-week process over the summer, creating “Clayscapes.” She focuses on stains and oxides mixed with water and painted directly on bone dry clay. After firing, the paintings are mounted to local hard wood.

In the exhibit cases, the sculpture of Sally LaMarche is on display. Her pieces are figures of stoneware and bronze.

A reception will be held on Tuesday, Oct. 13 from 5pm-8pm.
