APPLICANTS NEEDED FOR SPRINGFIELD LIBRARY BOARD POSITIONS

The City is seeking applications for two (2) volunteer positions on the Springfield Library Board. The deadline for applications has been extended to **5:00 p.m. Friday, September 23, 2011**. Both of the chosen applicants will serve a four-year term upon appointment. To be eligible, applicants must be registered voters and live within the city limits. (One member of the board may live outside the city if he or she owns property inside the city limits)

Applications:

Applications are due by **5:00 p.m. Friday, September 23, 2011** and are available at the City Manager's Office in City Hall, 225 Fifth Street and at the Library located at the same address inside City Hall. Interviews will be conducted during October with the Library Board forwarding its recommendations for appointment to the Mayor and City Council following.

Background:

The Springfield Library Board acts as a citizen sounding board on current library services including review of library policies and procedures. It also participates in the Library's strategic planning process and the future development of library services in Springfield including both facilities and funding strategies. It meets most first Tuesdays of each month at 5:30 p.m. in the Springfield City Hall.
