SHORT STORY WRITING CONTEST FOR TEENS

Teens invited to write about the white horse, the totem pole or the water tower

Writers in grades 6-12 are invited to submit a short story for the Springfield Public Library's 2011 Teen Short Story Writing Contest. Teens are invited to write a short story mentioning one of these three Springfield area landmarks: The White Horse Statue, the Springfield Water Tower, or the totem pole in Willamette Heights Park. The Grand Prize is \$50 sponsored by the Springfield Arts Commission, to be chosen from all entries.

Stories must be *1200 words or less and proper grammar is required*. One \$50 Grand Prize winner will be chosen with books and journals awarded for honorable mentions.
