Request for applicants to serve on the TSP Stakeholder Advisory Committee

The City of Springfield is recruiting four additional representatives to serve on the Springfield Transportation System Plan (TSP) Update Stakeholder Advisory Committee. Persons interested in serving should pick up an application from the Springfield Transportation and Engineering Division at Springfield City Hall. Completed forms are due by Wednesday, February 29th before 5:00 pm in the Transportation and Engineering Division office.

The TSP Update will establish a system of transportation facilities, services and policies to meet long-range needs for the City of Springfield. The Committee will provide on-going communication during the TSP project; review, evaluate, discuss and comment on information as it becomes available; and formulate recommendations for Planning Commission and City Council consideration. People with a background in: freight, Main Street and/or Glenwood area businesses, schools, or bicycle transportation are encouraged to apply.

The Committee will meet approximately four more times through the end of the project in fall 2012. The next meeting is anticipated to be mid-March 2012. Project team staff will review Committee member applications and make final selection of the Committee.
