

# FISH-FRIENDLY CAR WASH KITS



Available to non-profit groups **FREE** of charge

Does your non-profit group or club hold car wash fundraisers?

Have you ever thought about what happens to the soapy, dirty wash water?

When you hold car washes in a parking lot or other paved area the soapy, grimy water goes down a storm drain, directly into our community's rivers and streams without treatment. The soap, dirt, and oil that is in the water can be very harmful to fish and other aquatic life.

The Cities of Eugene and Springfield have car wash kits available, for **FREE**, that will keep the soapy water from your fundraiser out of our local waterways.

The kits contain all of the materials necessary (including easy to follow instructions) to direct the wash water into the sanitary sewer system where it is treated properly, before it is released into the Willamette River.

There are a number of sites in the Eugene/Springfield area that have been approved for the kits. If you have a favorite location for your fundraisers and want to know if it has the characteristics necessary to use the kit, please call the appropriate number.
