ADDENDUM #2

The City of Springfield is hereby amending the above mentioned RFP. The original document can be found on the City's website at www.springfield-or.gov. By selecting the hyperlink *Purchasing/Contracts* from the menu on the left side of the home page, interested parties will be linked to the RFP/ITB page.

- 1. Question:** Within the preliminary scope of work there is a request for geologic investigation to be handled by either a geologist or geotechnical engineer. However, when the soils analysis report is to be given, it is only shown to be stamped by a geotechnical engineer. In this case, an engineering geologist would be able to apply as much knowledge to subsurface conditions as it applies to the project due to the fact that no loads above ground will be increased from construction where a geotechnical engineer would be more applicable if that was the case. So the final question would be, would the final subsurface exploration report be able to be stamped by either an engineering geologist "or" geotechnical engineer licensed in the state of Oregon.

City's Response: Replace the fourth sentence under the Pre-design task in the Scope of Engineering Services that references the State of Oregon Licensure with, "The results of the soil explorations shall be documented in a geotechnical engineering report prepared and stamped by a licensed engineer or geologist in the State of Oregon."
