Appliances, scrap lumber, scrap metal, computers/electronics, TV's, yard debris, building materials (doors, windows, cabinets, etc.), plastics, furniture, automotive batteries (no cracks or leaks), clothes (dry and bagged), and clean Styrofoam.

### Please note these limits:

Propane tanks - limit 3 per vehicle

Tires - limit 5 per vehicle; no semi-truck or tractor tires

### The following items CANNOT be accepted:

Paint, household garbage, chemicals, or fluorescent lights.

Loads in enclosed vehicles, such as moving trucks.
