Project Description: The Booth Kelly Center is a 17 acre site with over 200,000 square feet of large industrial/commercial buildings. Most of the buildings are over 50 years old and in need of repair and modernization. This project is to have a qualified inspector evaluate building structures, envelopes and mechanical, electrical, plumbing and specialty systems. Examples are roof coverings, building exterior walls, boilers, fixtures, electrical distribution systems, and building wiring and plumbing. Each system will be evaluated and assigned an action level needed to restore the system to its original condition. The term "action level" refers to the level or nature of the repair required to restore the system to its original condition.

Examples of action levels are:
