*An author event with Tom Titus at the Springfield Library*

On Saturday, Sept. 12, 2015 at 3pm, author Tom Titus will be reading from his work, *Blackberries in July: A Forager's Field Guide to Inner Peace*. The book describes his return to Oregon, a year-long chronology of the hunting and gathering of his spirit that became a reunion with the Pacific Northwest and intergenerational tradition.
