Applications for Pedestrian and Bicycle Advisory Committee Available

The City of Springfield is seeking 5-9 Springfield residents to serve on a Pedestrian and Bicycle Advisory Committee; applications will be accepted until June 24 at noon.

This one-year “pilot” committee will meet a total of four times during the course of the year.
