## **SPRINGFIELD ARTS COMMISSION CHARITY ART SHOW**

*100% of sale price will go to the charity of the artist's choice*

Artists have causes they like to support, as well as unsold pieces that they'd prefer to place in good homes rather than in storage. Here's how to do both. Bring them to the City Hall Gallery for our second charity show in November 2011.

Here's how it will work:

Please pre-register to show by calling or emailing Carrie Schindele-Cupples, Arts Commission Liaison, at (541) 726-2237 or [scupples@springfield-or.gov](mailto:scupples@springfield-or.gov). Pre-registration helps us to prepare for entries; there is no juried process for this show.

Bring artwork to Springfield City Hall on Saturday, October 29 from 2-5 p.m. This is not limited to one piece per artist as the work will be sold off the wall through the month of November. The buyer's money will be sent to the charity of choice in the artist's name. As the work is removed from the wall, participating artists are welcome (encouraged) to replace work to continue sales through the end of the month. Artists must arrange to have unsold artwork picked up on Wednesday, November 30, 2011 between 3-6pm.

The work must be ready to hang. Lighter weight, unframed work on paper or card may be attached to the wall using t-pins. Three-dimensional work is welcome to be sold from the cases, but may require a short waiting period for the buyer, as the cases are more difficult to handle.

Recipients from the first charity show included the United Negro College Fund, the Heifer Project, and the Emerald Art Center.

Gallery hours are: Monday and Tuesday, 8am-8pm; Wednesday and Thursday, 8am-6pm; Friday, 8am-5pm; Saturday, 12pm-5pm; Sundays, closed.
