SPRINGFIELD CITY HALL GALLERY EXHIBIT & RECEPTION

Two exhibits, Shared Communities/Mixed Identities and "If we build it..." a participatory art exhibit on bicycle transportation in the Netherlands, will be on display; A reception will be held on Friday, January 13, 2012 as part of Springfield's Downtown ArtWalk

CALC, Community Alliance of Lane County, presents a photo exhibit entitled *Shared Communities/Mixed Identities*. The exhibit will be on display from Tuesday, January 3, 2012 through the end of the month in the Springfield City Hall Gallery. The Gallery is operated by the Springfield Arts Commission.

The exhibit entitled "If we build it..." is a participatory art exhibit on bicycle transportation in the Netherlands. Viewers are invited to write their own captions for photos and video taken by University of Oregon students who participated in a bicycle transportation field seminar. The exhibit will be on display in the City Hall Lobby January 9 -20, 2012.

The Springfield Arts Commission will host a reception at the City Hall Gallery as part of Springfield's Second Friday Downtown Art Walk on Friday, December 9 from 5-7pm. Light refreshments will be offered.

The Mayor's featured artist for January is Craig Lasha. His work will be on display, in the Mayor's office, during the reception on January 13, 2012.

Music during the reception will be provided by Jet & Johnny, an upright bass and acoustic guitar duo playing acoustic jazz and blues.
