Update on Storm Clean-up (March 22, 9:20 a.m.)

The task of cleaning and trimming up the tree damage continues and will likely be the work focus for several days. Tree work will be prioritized by critical hazard first, next damage blocking vehicle traffic, then on to sidewalk and pedestrian facilities. There will also be a couple of crews out today dealing with minor street drainage problems. Street sweeping will ramp back up tomorrow. We will also keep an eye on the potential for flooding as the river flows are not expected to peak until Friday or Saturday.

For citizens that have already called in tree service requests for public right-of-way trees, there isn't a need to call those in again. For folks that have yet to communicate tree, drainage, or lingering snow and ice concerns, please contact the Maintenance Division office at 541-726-3761.
