Lane County Veterans Day Parade in Springfield

This year's parade includes a pre and post parade event.

The Lane County Veterans' Day Parade is this Veterans Day, Sunday November 11th starting at 1:30 p.m. From 8-10 a free Pancake Breakfast (pancakes, eggs, sausage, coffee, juice and milk) will be offered to the public by Springfield Lutheran Church, 1542 'T' Street. Following the Parade at 1650 Centennial Blvd (the old Waremart parking lot) the public are invited to join the Camp Creek Tractor Club for a viewing of over 20 vintage tractors. The Copper Windmill Ranch will present an authentic World War I U.S. Army wagon drawn by a mule team, as well as variety of additional interesting parade entries. Evergreen Title will provide hotdogs and drinks.

The Parade route begins at 21st and Olympic, proceeds west to Mohawk Blvd, south on to Mohawk Blvd, right on to 'G' Street and disbursing at 10th Street. The reviewing stage will be on the east side of Mohawk Blvd at the NW side of the McKenzie-Willamette Hospital across from the Veterans Memorial at the NE corner of Willamalane Park.

As traditions hold, the Confederated Tribes of the Coos, Lower Umpqua and Siuslaw Indians will once again provide the honor guard. To mention only a few, some of the dignitaries planning to make an appearance are Springfield Navy Veteran Mayor Christine Lundberg, Marine Veteran and Springfield Police Chief Jerry Smith, Marine Sgt. Major Jess Wise, Retired, and Air Force Veteran and Springfield City Councilman Dave Ralston.
