CITY SEEKS APPLICANT FOR METROPOLITAN WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT COMMISSION

The City of Springfield is accepting applications for the Metropolitan Wastewater Management Commission (MWMC). Citizens interested in applying may pick up an application in the City Manager's Office, 225 Fifth Street, during regular business hours. The application deadline is 5 p.m. on Friday, December 28, 2012. The City Council will review applications at their January 28, 2013 Work Session and make the appointment at their February 4, 2013 Regular Council Meeting.

The Commission is a seven-member policy-making body which oversees administration of the regional wastewater collection and treatment facilities serving the Eugene-Springfield metropolitan area. The cities of Eugene and Springfield provide operations, maintenance, and administration of the regional wastewater program under contract with the Commission. The Commission is comprised of citizen representatives and elected officials. The Commission holds its meetings at 7:30 a.m. the second Friday of each month at the Springfield City Hall or the Eugene/Springfield Water Pollution Control Facility. Other meetings and work sessions are held as necessary. The selected applicant will be appointed by the Mayor and must reside within the Eugene city limits.
