### **SPRINGFILM AT THE WILDISH THEATER**

*A FREE monthly film & discussion program in downtown Springfield will show the documentary, When We Were Kings*

The monthly film and discussion series, SpringFILM, will screen its next documentary at the Wildish Theater on Wednesday, January 15, 2014 at 6pm. The featured film is *When We Were Kings*, a documentary of the 1974 heavyweight championship bout in Zaire between champion George Foreman and underdog challenger Muhammad Ali. Directed by Leon Gast; rated PG; 89 minutes; 1996.

The post-film discussion will be moderated by Dr. Johnny Lake of Northwest Christian University. Dr. Lake is an assistant professor of education, with specific focus and interest on the impact and influence of diversity, race and culture on student academic performance and achievement.

The program is free to attend and coordinated by a partnership among the Springfield Library, the Springfield Museum and Willamalane Park and Recreation District.
