Teens, you can be a real life hero if you have the skills. Join us for five days of hero training from July 27th to 30th at the Springfield Public Library from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. each day. On Monday we will get ready for “the big one” with emergency preparedness taught by the Community Emergency Response Team. Tuesday is first-aid and survival training taught by the Willamette Pass Ski Patrol. On Wednesday the Eugene Springfield Fire Department will teach fire safety and Thursday you can learn self-defense

techniques with Warrior Sisters. We will end the week with a Rescue Fair at Springfield Fire Station #3. You can run the rescue maze, put out a real fire and tour the fire station. Fire Station #3 is located at 1225 28th Street in Springfield. This program is for teens ages 12 to 19.
