The *Springfield Election Information* provides citizens with valuable information about candidates and measures that will appear on the ballot in Springfield, Oregon. Printed copies of the *Springfield Election Information* are available at the Springfield City Manager's Office, Springfield Public Library, and Springfield Justice Center.

The *Springfield Election Information* provides information for the following City of Springfield Mayor and Council positions that will be on the May 17, 2016 Primary Election:

- Mayor
- City Councilor, Ward 3
- City Councilor, Ward 4
- City Councilor, Ward 6

There are no city measures scheduled for the May 17, 2016 Primary Election.

The Springfield City Charter requires a primary election for Springfield Mayor and City Councilors. If a candidate receives a majority of votes at the primary election, that candidate is elected. If a candidate does not receive a majority of votes at the primary election, then a run-off between the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes will occur at the statewide general election on Tuesday, November 8, 2016.
