Illustrator, Painter and Author will discuss his work at the Springfield Library

On Saturday, Feb. 6 at 2pm, the Springfield Library presents a question and answer session with artist Alan M. Clark. The event is presented by the Springfield Library Foundation as part of the “Springfield Library Foundation Author and Music Series,” and the Springfield Arts Commission.

Clark is a graduate of the San Francisco Art Institute.
