3. Design to enhance the overall appearance of the corridor for all users, improve pedestrian safety and usage, and provide traffic calming for vehicles.

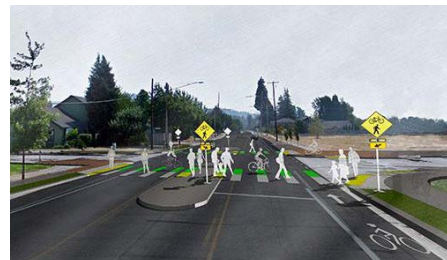
