Shift in Schedule for Start of Construction

The start of the construction portion of the project has been shifted out to spring 2019. The City had to make this shift due to staffing shortages that delayed the start of the engineering design work for the project. While the construction phase start will be later than originally anticipated, the engineering design work is still scheduled to be completed this fall and the construction bid process will happen this coming winter. Some pieces of the project may need to follow as a second construction phase, dependent upon design schedule funding.

We have heard from some of you about your frustration with the construction delay and appreciate you taking the time to share your frustration and thoughts. Staff has many of the same frustrations when there are project delays. We are moving forward as quickly as we can.

S. 54th Street Multi-Use Path

The City has received federal transportation funds to construct a multi-use path in the undeveloped S. 54th Street right of way between the end of the existing paved surface and Daisy Street. The City is currently working on the design, and the City's Operations Division is looking at the potential for building the project in the fall of this year.

At key project milestones, corridor residents and property owners will also receive mail about the project. However, email updates will be sent out more frequently than paper mail.


