We are reaching out to let you know that this project will not be a topic of discussion on Council's agenda for August 19. Since our latest update, an opportunity has emerged for the City to take a holistic look at how comprehensive planning in Springfield can best accomplish Springfield's needs through [Council goals](#) and coordinated delivery of services. This big-picture look will occur as a Work Session on September 16. The goal of this Work Session is to help prioritize the City's comprehensive planning work in the months ahead, which may include continued progress on the Downtown Design Standards project.
