



Capital Infrastructure Program (18%)


Land Use Planning (5%)


Revenues by Fund

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


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Project Priorities

- Based on 5 Year Capital Improvement Program (CIP)
- o CIP Updated every two years with public input
- CIP is a Program of Needed Projects
- Capital Budget funds Specific Projects









Sources of Project Funding

- State and Local Fuel Taxes
- Sewer and Drainage User Fees
- o Bonds
- o Grants
- System Development Charges
- Majority (~90%) Federal Aid Transportation Not in Budget

- Regional Fuel Facility Upgrades
- Pedestrian Activated Signal at 66th and Main Street
- First two Street Bond Projects




