Due to an unforeseen website linking issue, we are resending this e-update with the website links working properly.

Changes to Phase 1 Scope and Timeline

Since the last e-update, an evaluation of the funding sources for Phase 1 construction was conducted. Based on the evaluation, staff concluded that due to funding constraints the scope of Phase 1 construction needed to be split into two parts. Phase 1A area is now just east of 42nd Street to just west of 51st Place. Phase 1A will include three raised crossings, tree wells and planters, ADA ramps, sidewalk repairs, an asphalt pavement overlay, and stormwater features as outlined in the [Final Corridor Design Concept](#). Additionally, the buffered bike lanes east of S 54th Street will be painted in 2020.

Phase 1A detailed engineering design plans are expected to go out to bid to solicit a construction contract in fall 2019. Additional phases will be selected for construction as design is completed and funding is secured.

We acknowledge that residents have been anticipating this work to occur sooner. We appreciate your patience as staff navigates the funding sources and constraints that have occurred for this project.

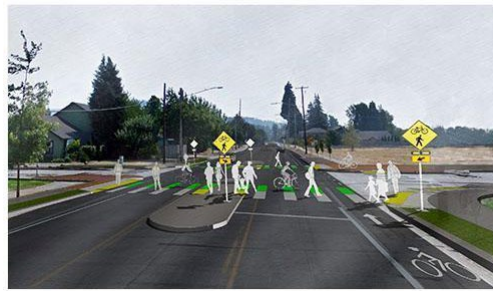
