

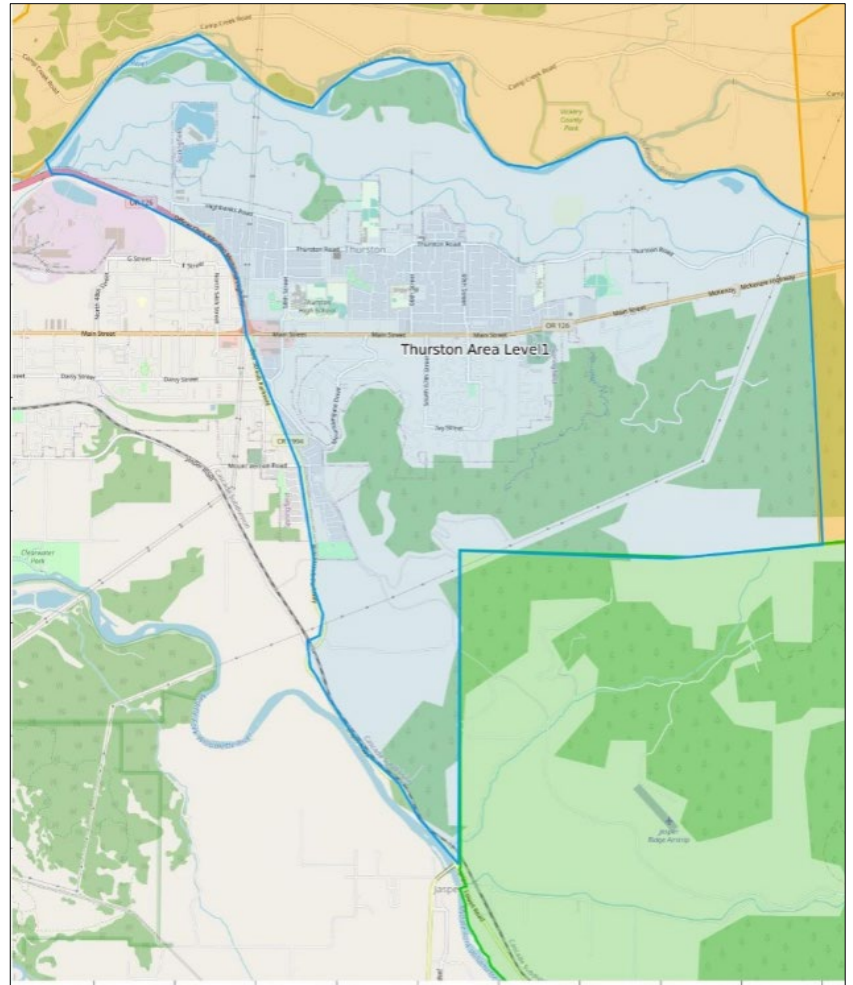
LEVEL 1 BE READY EVACUATION NOTICE

Notice posted on:
September 9, 2020

Lane County has issued a **Level 1 Evacuation Notice** for all residences and businesses from Highway 126 to Bob Straub to Jasper Road east to Thurston Road where it intersects with Highway 126 north to the McKenzie River.

LEVEL 1 means be aware of the danger that exists in your area and prepare for possible evacuation.

The **blue area** on this map shows the part of Springfield the **Level 1 Evacuation Notice** has been issued for:



More on a Level 1 Evacuation Notice - Be Ready:

This means you should be aware of the danger that exists in the area, monitor emergency services websites and local media for information. This is the time for preparation and the precautionary movement of people with special needs, mobile property and (under certain circumstances) pets and livestock. If conditions worsen, emergency services personnel may contact you via an emergency notification system.
